It is an opportunity to showcase your talent in the garden, and with cookery, wine and photography. There are cups for the winner of each section and a trophy for the overall winner. Plenty of opportunity for good-humoured competition!

Everyone is welcome to submit entries, and we hope that whether entering or not, you will come for afternoon tea and enjoy the traditional activities, stalls, games, cake stall, children's races, BBQ, beer tent and plant stall.

### Rules

1. **Entries** must be submitted **between 8.00 and 10.00am** on the day.
2. An entrant can enter **ONE** entry in **each** class.
3. Each entrant will be given an anonymous entrant number, to be placed on each entry.
4. **Containers:** please supply your own vases/plates.
5. **Judging:** Judging will take place between 10:00 and 12:00. Judges will award 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places in each class at their discretion.
6. **Rosettes** will be awarded for judge's commendations.
7. **Points** are awarded for prizes. In each section the entrant with the most points will be awarded the **Section Cup**.
8. **Best in Show:** The **Trophy** will be awarded to the individual entry from any class judged to be the Best in Show.
9. **Childrens' Prizes:** Small money prizes will be given in the Junior Classes.
