## **Show competition rules**

1. **Entries** are only accepted **between 8.00 and 10.00am** on the day.
2. **An adult** is anyone 12 years and over, on the day.
3. **An entrant** can enter **ONE** entry in **each** class.
4. **Each entrant** will be given an anonymous entrant number, to be placed on each entry.
5. **Containers/plates/vases** are to be provided by the entrant
6. **Judging** will take place between 10:00 and 12:00. Judges will award 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each class at their discretion. **The decision of the judge is final.**
7. **Rosettes** will be awarded for judge's commendations.
8. **Points** are awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. The entrant with the most points in a section will be awarded the **Section Cup.**
9. **Best in Show** trophy will be awarded to the individual who has accrued the most competition points.
10. **Small money prizes** will be given in the Junior Classes.
